#### NSPCC

Year Five and Six have been visited by members of the NSPCC Team to talk about their safety and wellbeing. The children have learnt about different types of abuse in a child-friendly, age appropriate and sensitive way, so they can get help if or when they need it. They have been helped to identify safe adults, at home and in school, that they can talk to if they're ever worried about themselves or a friend. and have learnt about Childline, and how it can support them.

### Parking and Children Walking to and From School

We have had several reports of children running across the car park at the Leonard Brothers Vets and running across the road when walking up to school. We have spoken with the children, and I ask that you also reinforce the message of road safety and careful walking when on the car parks.
